The AgriTrade module on Extension Suite Online

During 2014, the DAFF Directorate: Food Import and Export Standards, approached Manstrat to assist them in making existing food import and export standards more readily available to officials using Extension Suite Online (ESO). Overlapping of authority and responsibility within the department is common due to the specialized nature of agricultural import and export controls. This situation often resulted in farmers and extension officers having to consult a number of sites controlled by different directorates, for simple information leading to frustration and time wasting. Commentary and complaints centered on the fact that the information was extremely difficult to extract and farmers often received inadequate or wrong information.

To solve the problem, the Directorate requested Manstrat AIS's assistance. The Directorate's initial suggestion was to place links on ESO to the DAFF website to enable officers using ESO, easy access to the different legal and departmental standards and norms.

The provision of links however, would not have solved the problem of the spread of information over numerous sites. Manstrat AIS specialists solved this by firstly creating a dedicated Main Navigation Tab (AgriTrade), on ESO. Secondly, they decided to copy each document individually from the DAFF website for display on ESO, and to create re-organised Information Modules on the system. This allowed MAIS to arrange and present the documents in a way that was familiar to our users, rather than a legal and prescriptive approach.

During the copying phase, personnel from the Data Research and Maintenance (DRM) Division found duplicates and other documents that were either removed or changed into pdf, and protected formats, to protect our client and ourselves.

The next step will be for DAFF personnel from the relevant directorates to access, check, replace and add to the current content of the new AgriTrade module. For this purpose, MAIS has created a special platform on the system with access limited to those involved.

The Main Menu Items created for the AgriTrade navigation tab are; Agri Inputs, Animal Health, Imports and Exports, Safety and Quality, Inspection Services, Plant Health, Veterinary Public Health and Veterinary Hygiene.

Once checking is completed and the display of the information agreed upon, the Tab will be uploaded onto ESO and the information will be available to all users.

Agricultural marketing tips

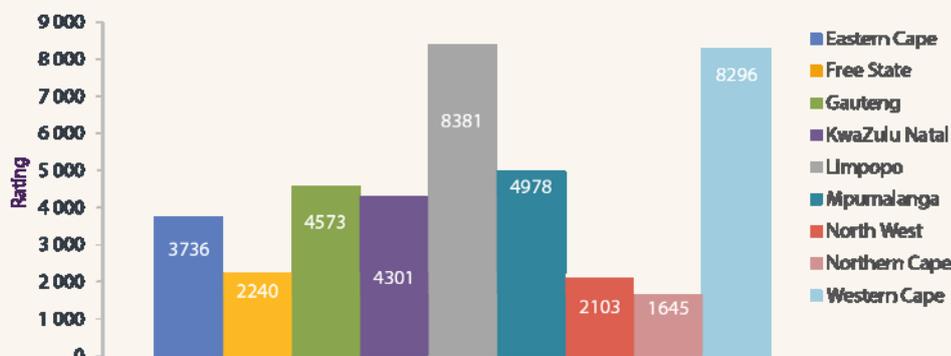

He says that the majority of Extension Practitioners work in wards where it is required of them to be a "jack of all trades", having to support both crop and animal farmers. "Extension Suite Online has simplified the act of gathering information and producing information that farmers can use anytime."

EXTENSION SUITE ONLINE UTILISATION: MARCH 2015

Extension Suite Online (ESO) utilisation is determined through monitoring user utilisation in the nine provinces and by attaching values to Visits, Pages Visited and Duration of Visits; a rating is calculated to establish the ESO National Top User of the Month.
