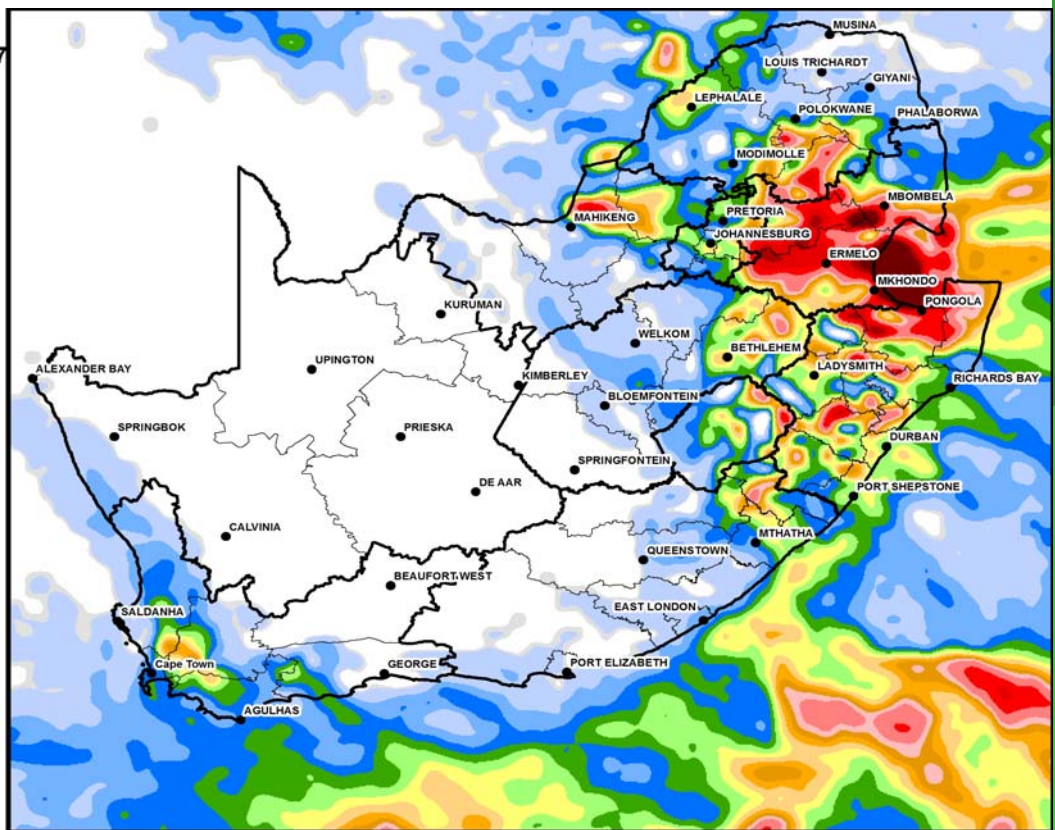
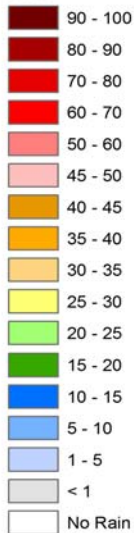

Good rainfall is expected over the Western Cape on Tuesday while the rest of the country remains dry. Scattered showers will bring rainfall to KZN throughout the week. From Thursday, thunderstorms will start to develop over the summer rainfall region bringing rainfall to most areas. More than 60 mm is expected over large parts of Mpumalanga.

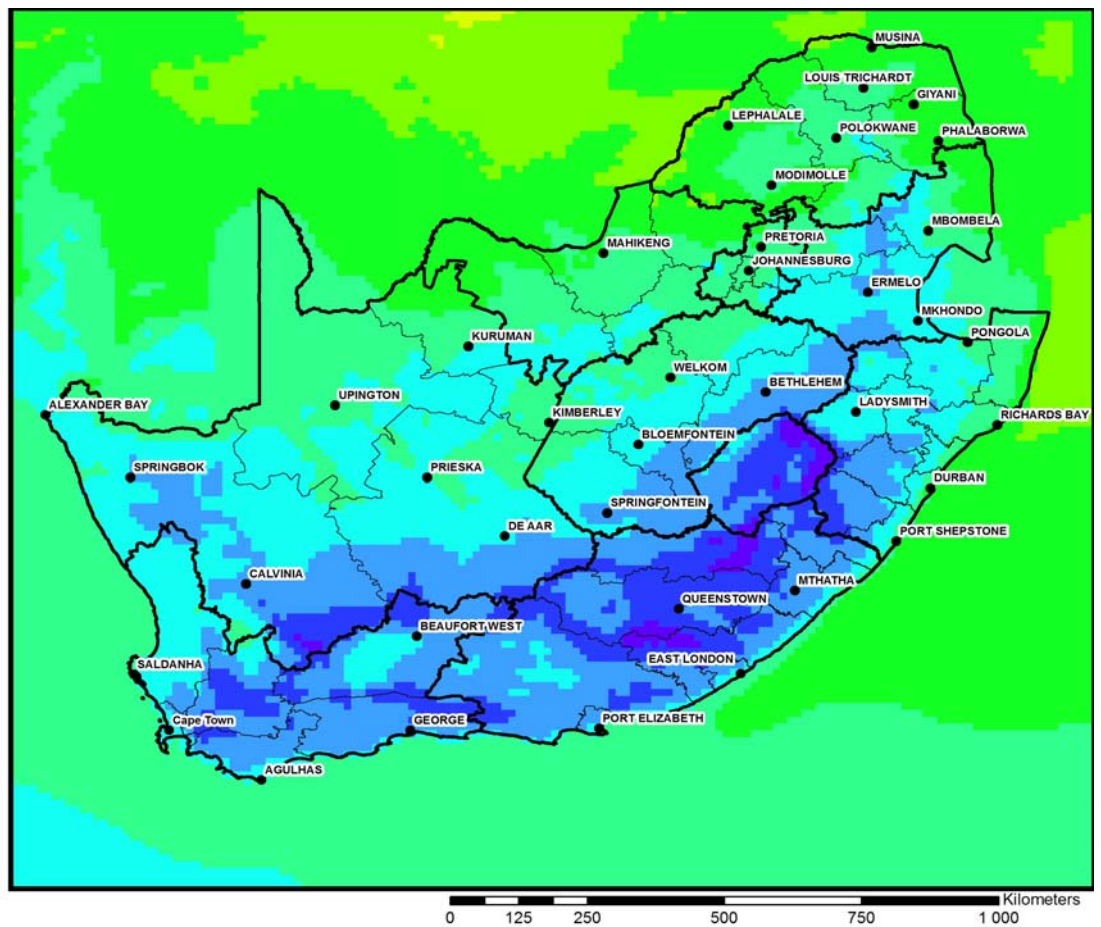
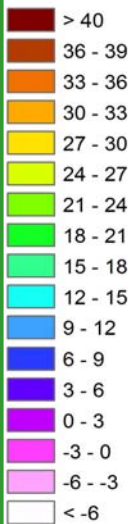




## Average Minimum Temperatures: 21 to 27 November 2017

The average minimum temperatures will increase over South Africa after last weeks' cold weather. While the increase in minimum temperatures is significant over the northern regions of South Africa, the southern half of South Africa will still experience cool temperatures in the morning.

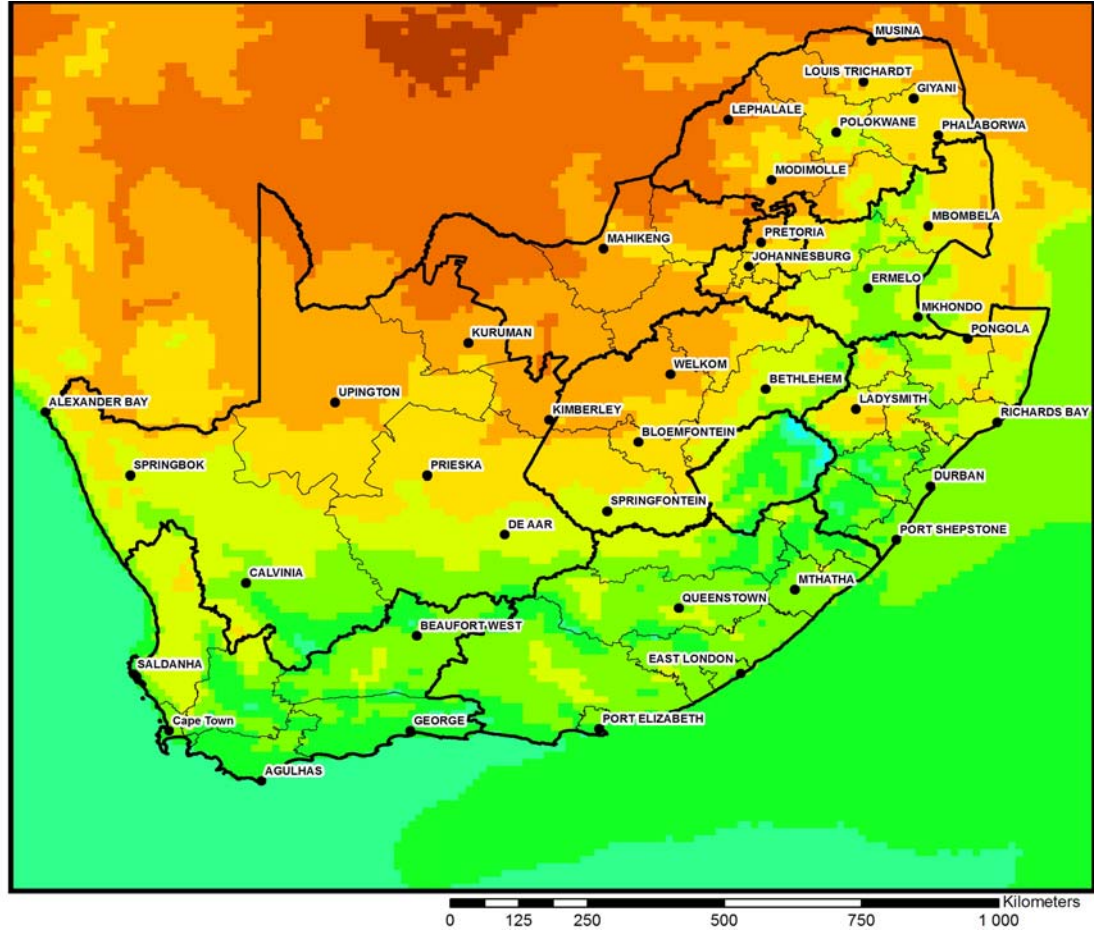




## Average Maximum Temperatures: 21 to 27 November 2017

Average maximum temperatures will recover significantly over the northern regions of South Africa. While the week will start off with very warm temperatures above 30°C over these areas, the temperatures over the north eastern areas will drop as a result of the rainfall over the weekend.

The southern regions of South Africa will continue to experience mild maximum temperatures.

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
