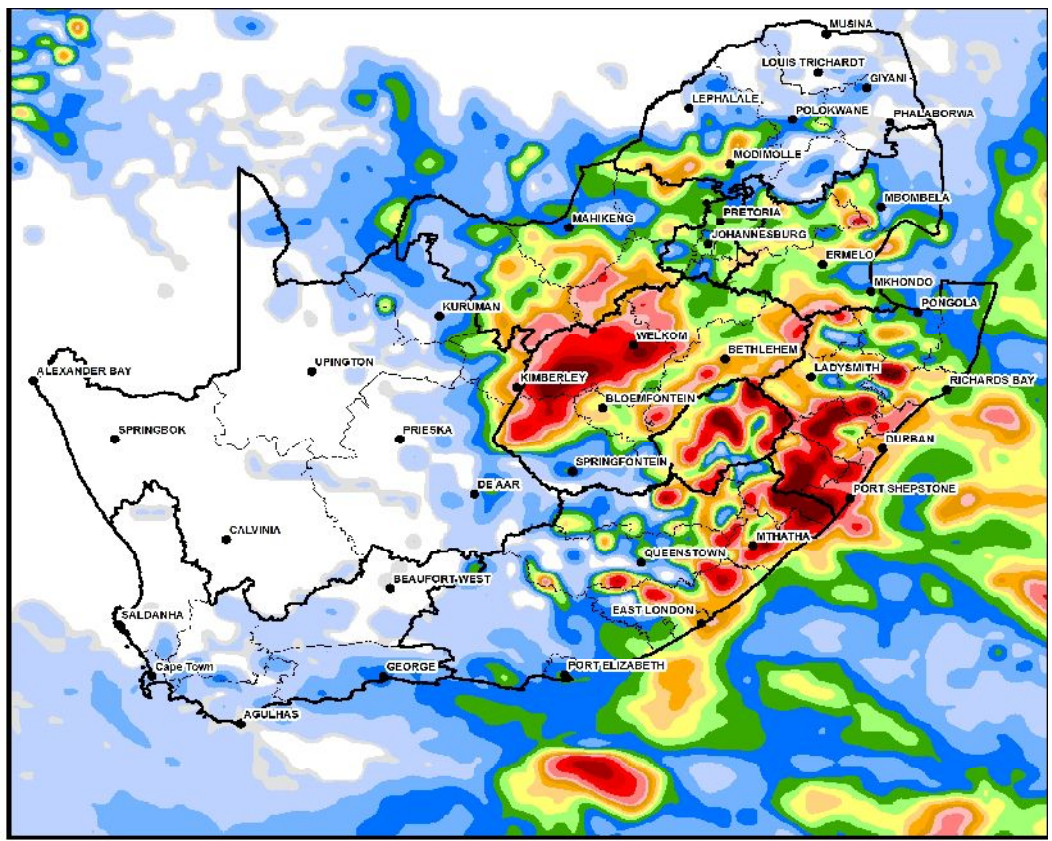
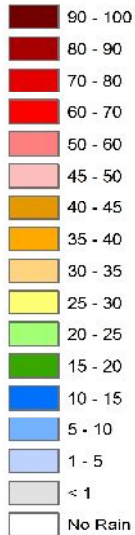


Figure 1: Expected precipitation 13-19 March 2018.

Average Minimum Temperatures: 13-19 March 2018

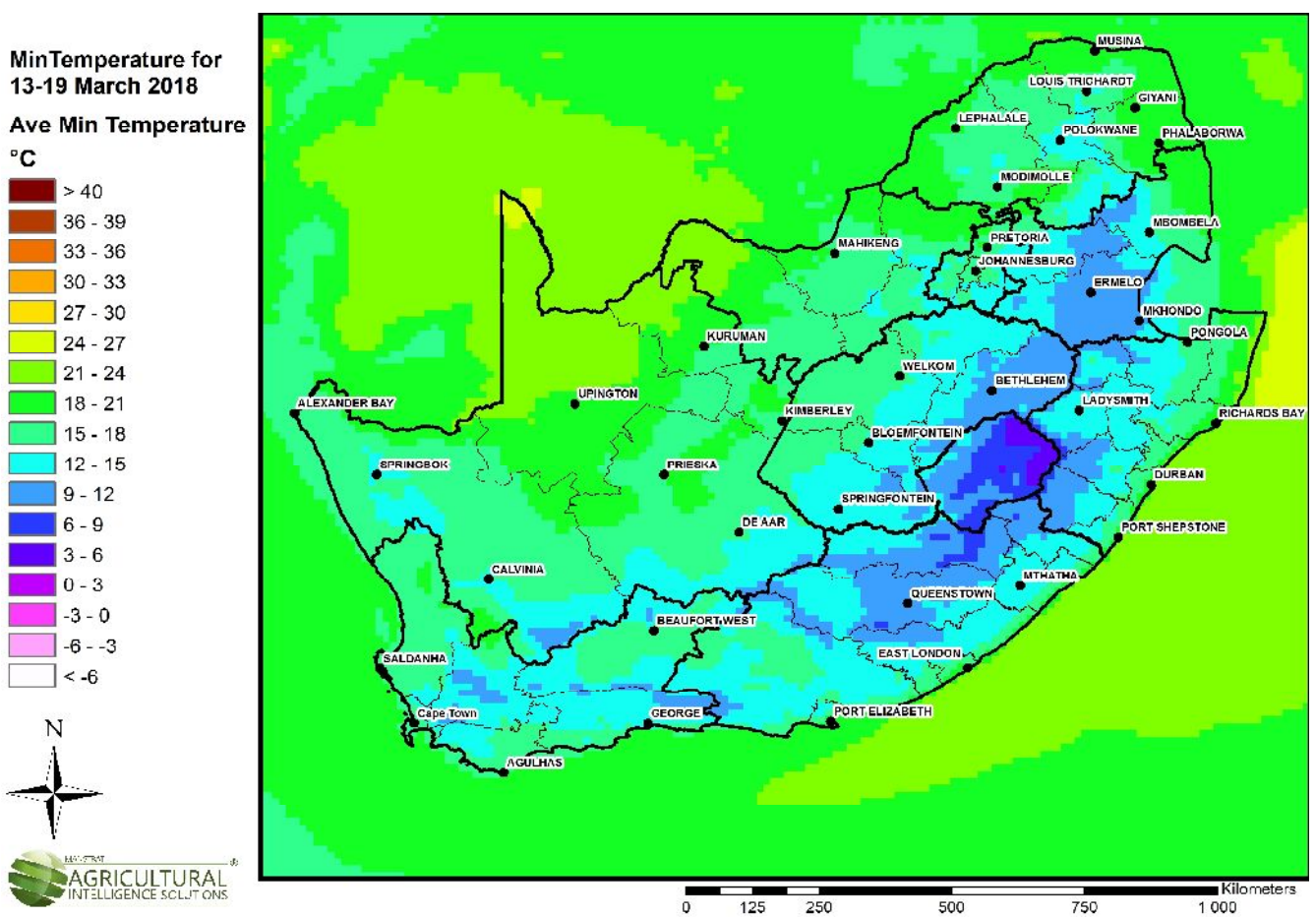


Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 13-19 March 2018.

A slight drop in minimum temperatures across the eastern and southern parts of South Africa is expected as we move into autumn. Normal minimum temperatures still expected for the northern regions of South Africa for this time of year.

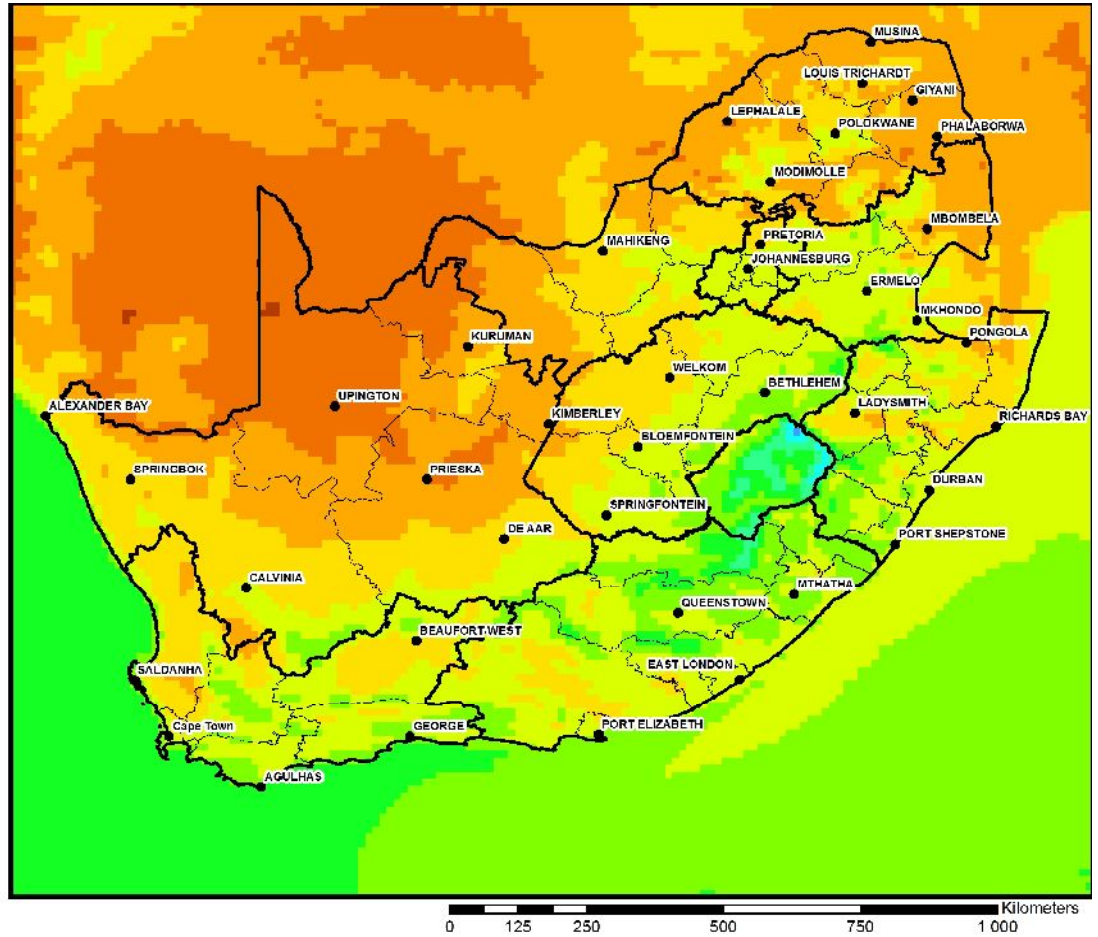
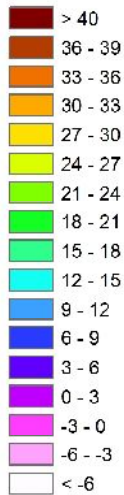


Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 13-19 March 2018
