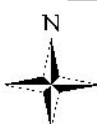
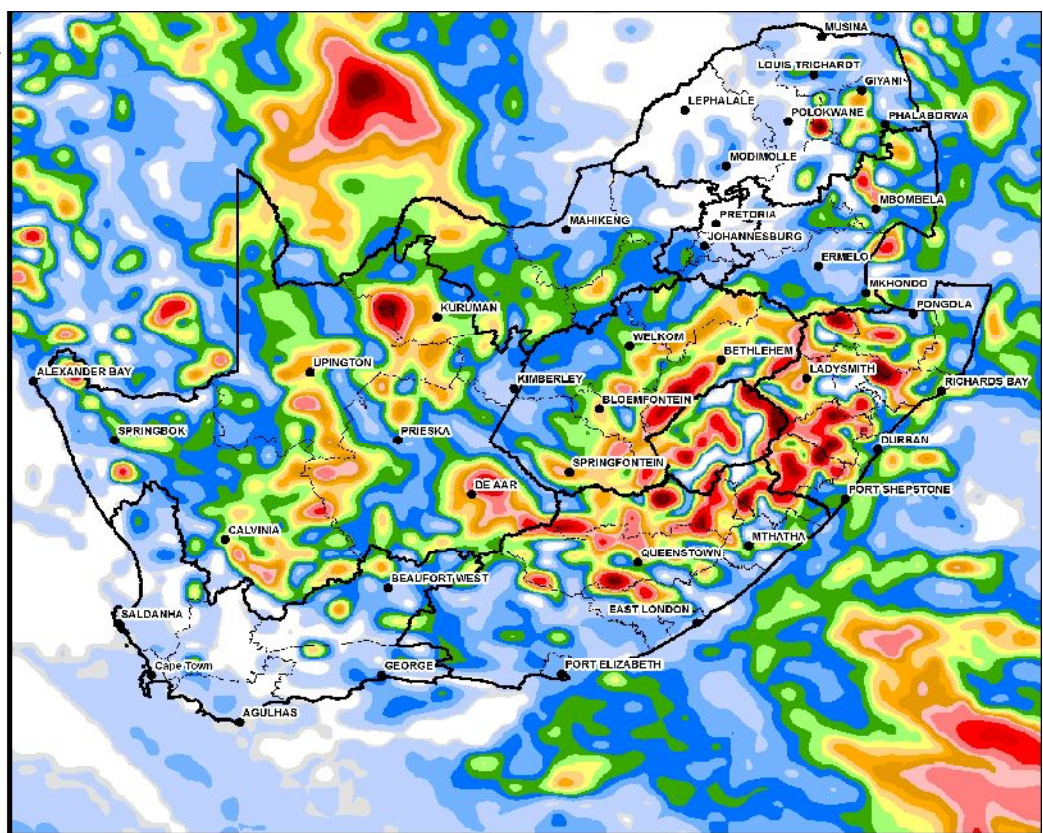
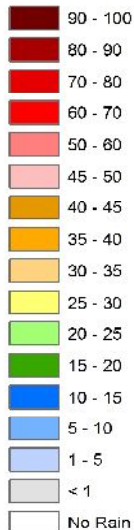

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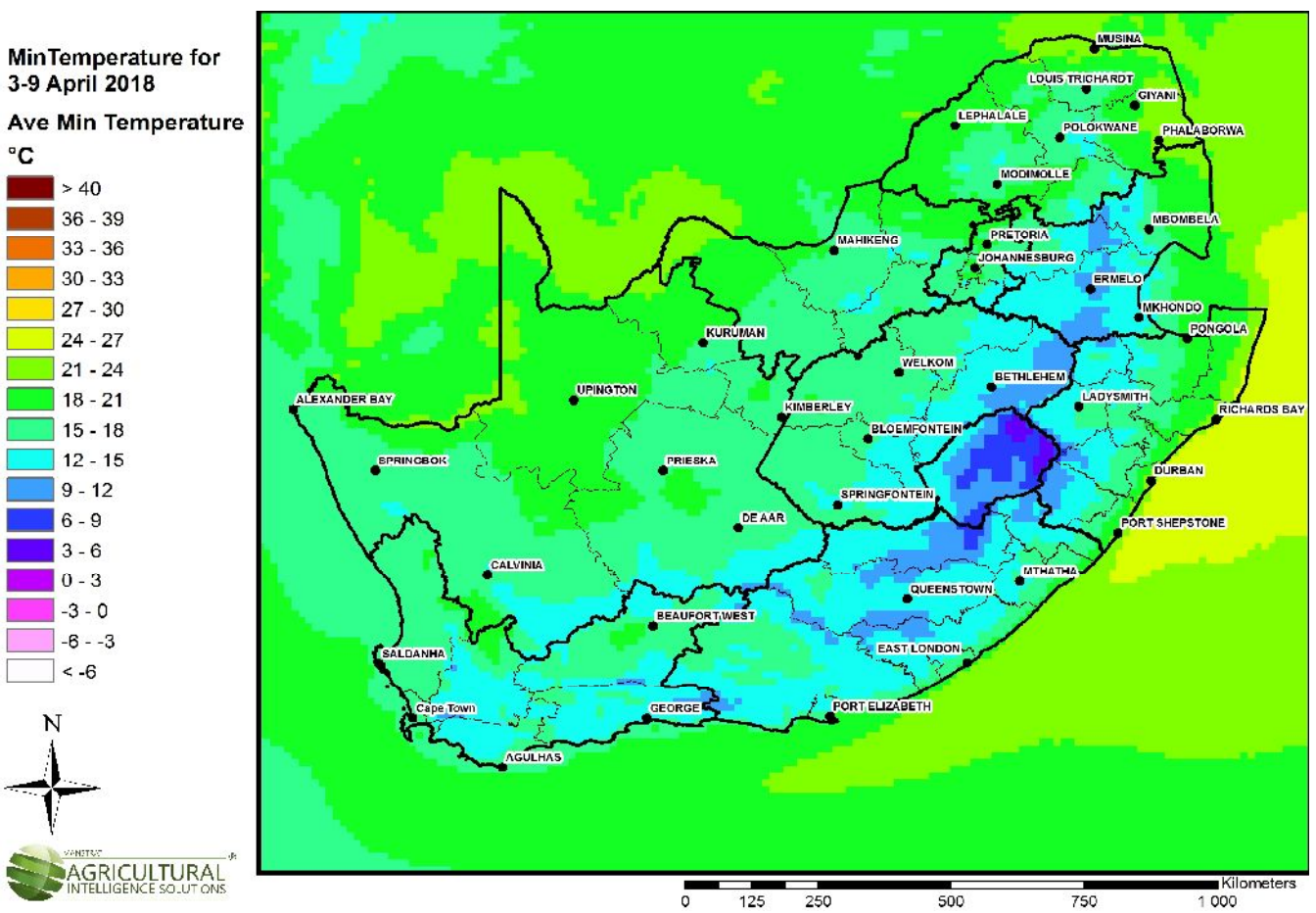
***Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 3-9 April 2018.***

## Average Minimum Temperatures: 3-9 April 2018

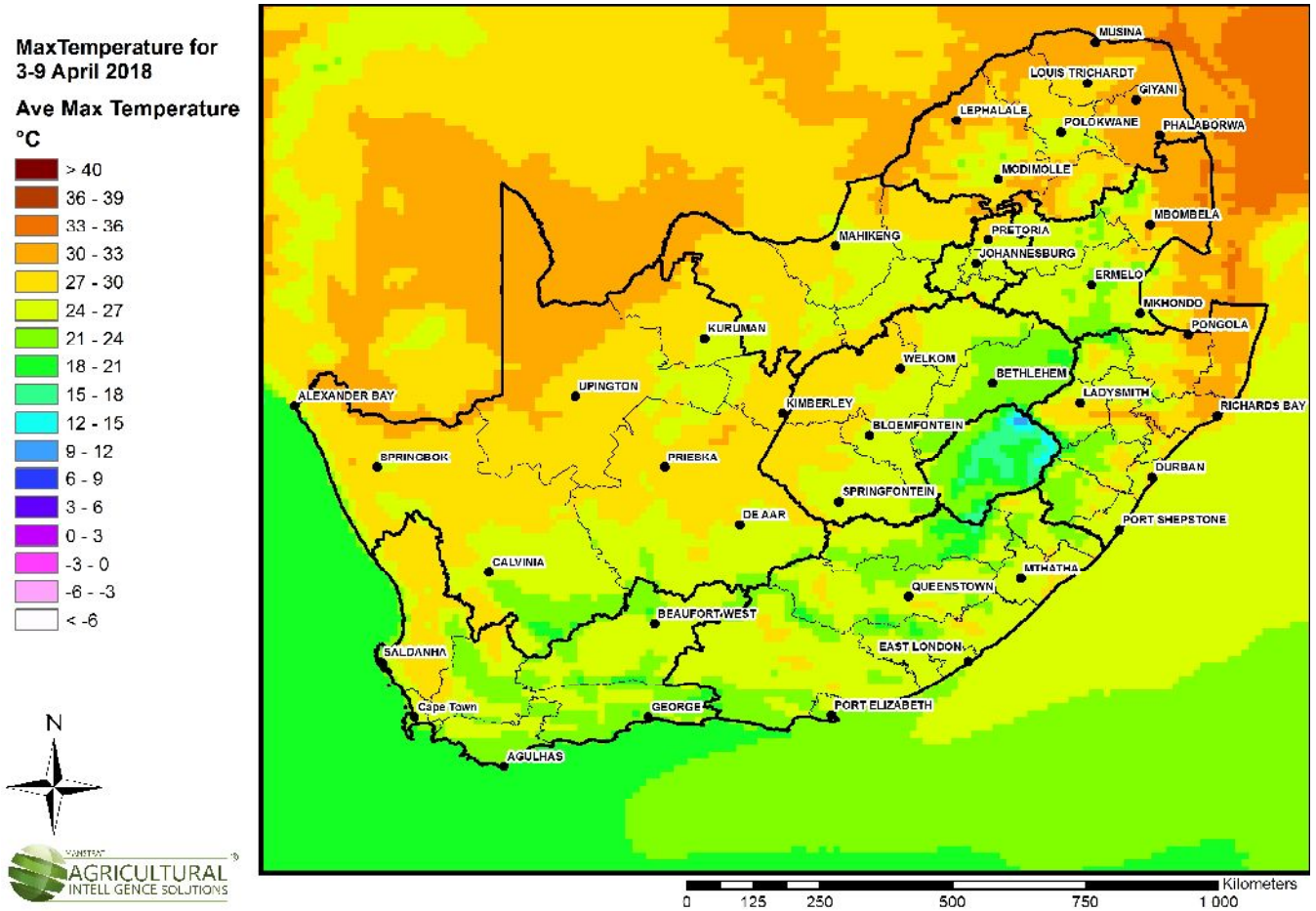


**Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 3-9 April 2018.**
