

## Weekly Outlook: Rainfall: 3-9 April 2018




Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 3-9 April 2018.

Scattered showers are expected over most areas of South Africa this week. The Northern Cape, Eastern Free State, northern Eastern Cape and KwaZulu-Natal will be the wettest areas this week with good rainfall expected. The Western Cape can expect a little, but welcome relief in the form of up to 5mm of rainfall.

## Average Minimum Temperatures: 3-9 April 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 3-9 April 2018.

## Average Maximum Temperatures: 3-9 April 2018




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures: 27 March 2018 to 2 April 2018
