10-16 April 2018

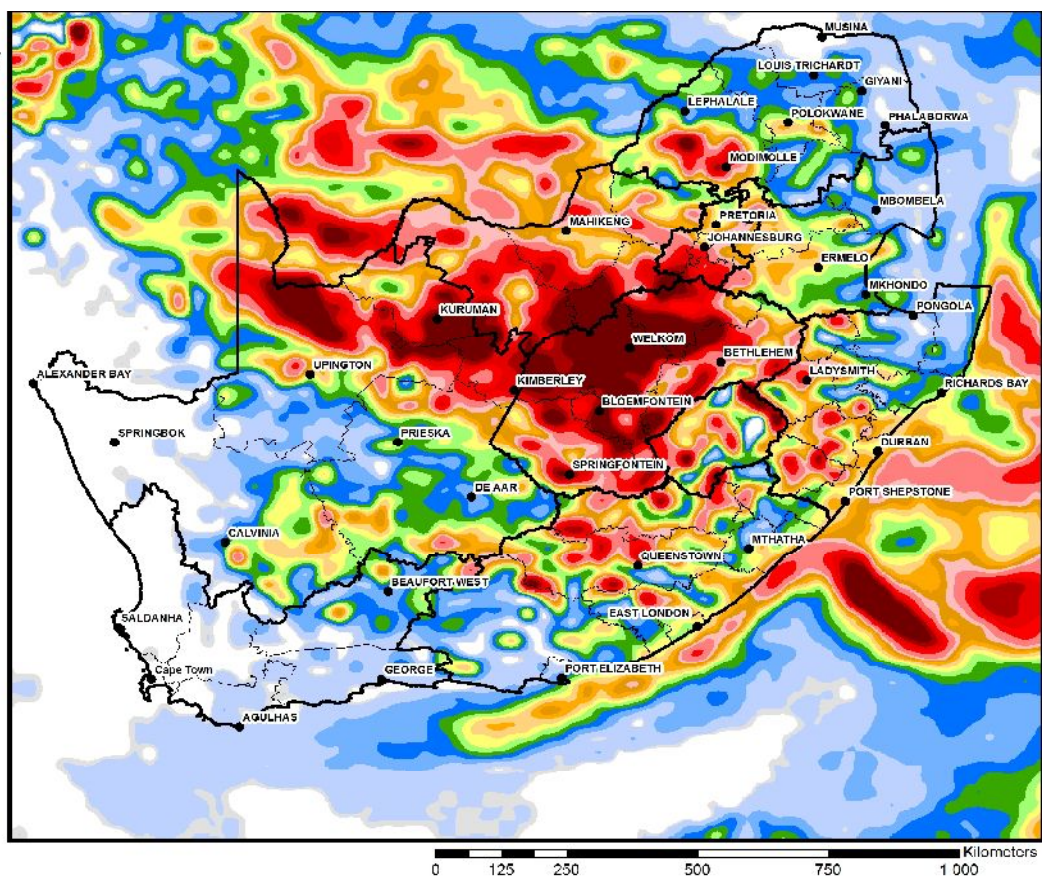
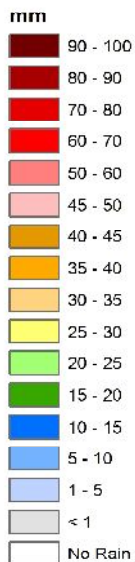


Figure 1: Expected precipitation 10-16 April 2018.

Scattered showers are expected over most areas of South Africa this week. Heavy showers are expected over the northern regions of the Northern Cape, North West and the Free State with up to 100 mm predicted for the week. Good rainfall also expected over southern KwaZulu-Natal and the northern Eastern Cape with up to 50 mm expected.





Average Minimum Temperatures: 10-16 April 2018

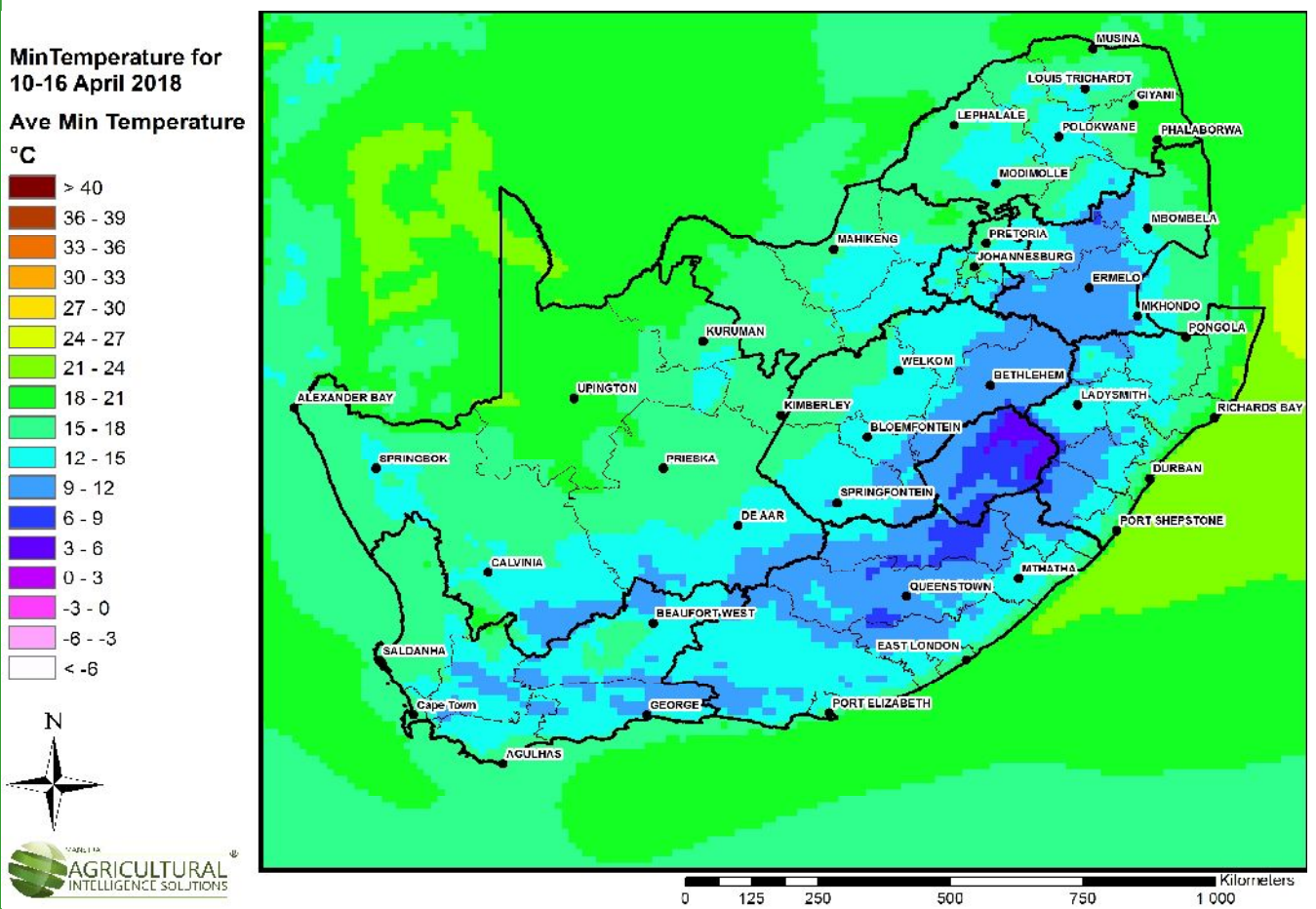


Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 10-16 April 2018.

Minimum temperatures are starting to drop across the country, especially along the escarpment of South Africa.





Average Maximum Temperatures: 10-16 April 2018

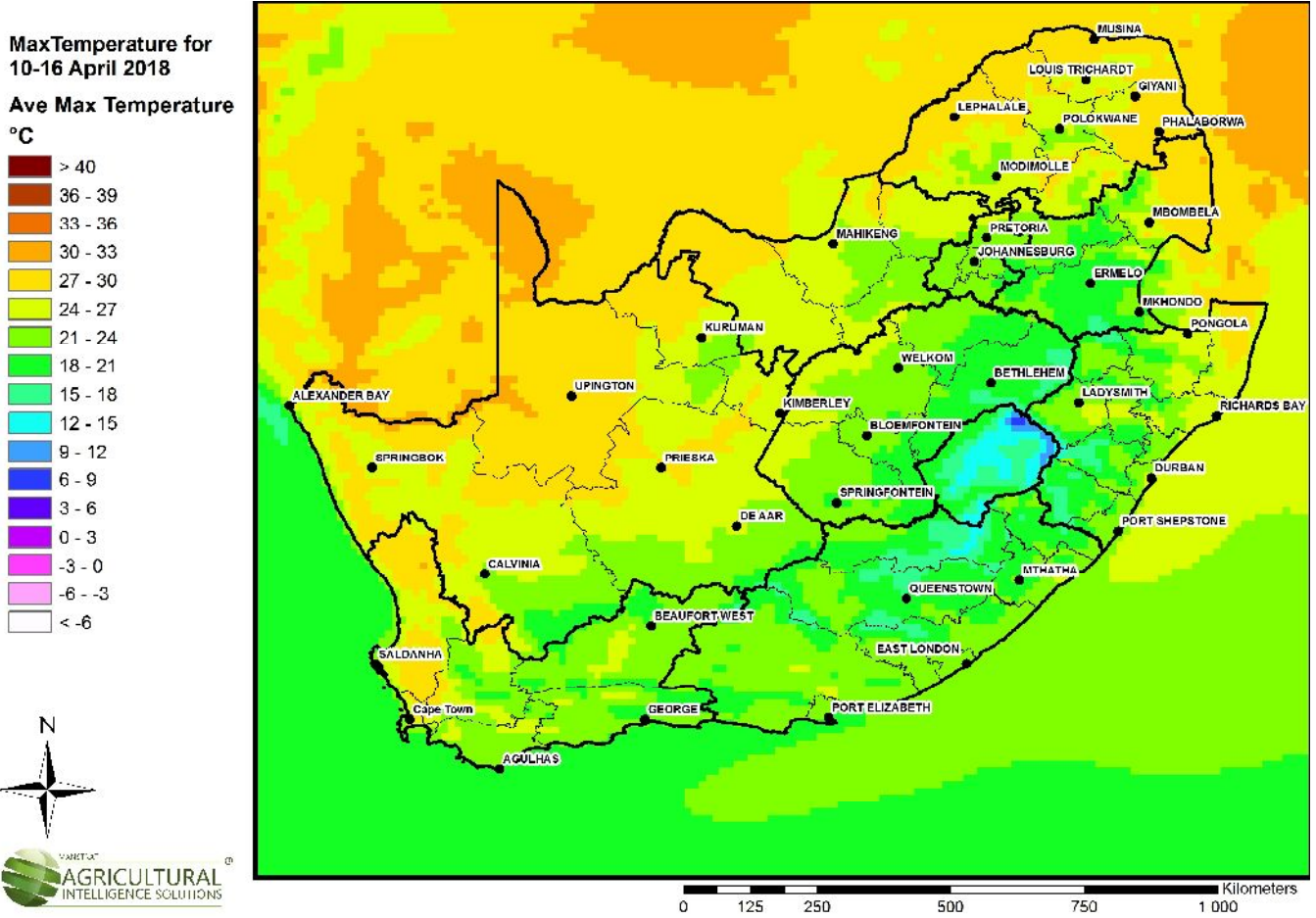


Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 10-16 April 2018.
