

Weekly Outlook: Rainfall: 24 to 30 April 2018




Figure 1: Expected precipitation 24 to 30 April 2018.

Up to 25 mm is expected to fall over the drought hit Western Cape region this week. The rest of the country remains dry, but good rainfall is expected over the Northern Cape and northern Eastern Cape later this week.

Average Minimum Temperatures: 24 to 30 April 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 24 to 30 April 2018.

Minimum temperatures continue to drop across the country. Dry air is in circulation over the northern parts of the country resulting in colder minimum temperatures this week while the cooler minimum temperatures along the coast is a result of cold fronts moving across the southern parts of the country.

Average Maximum Temperatures: 24 to 30 April 2018




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 24 to 30 April 2018.
