12-18 June 2018

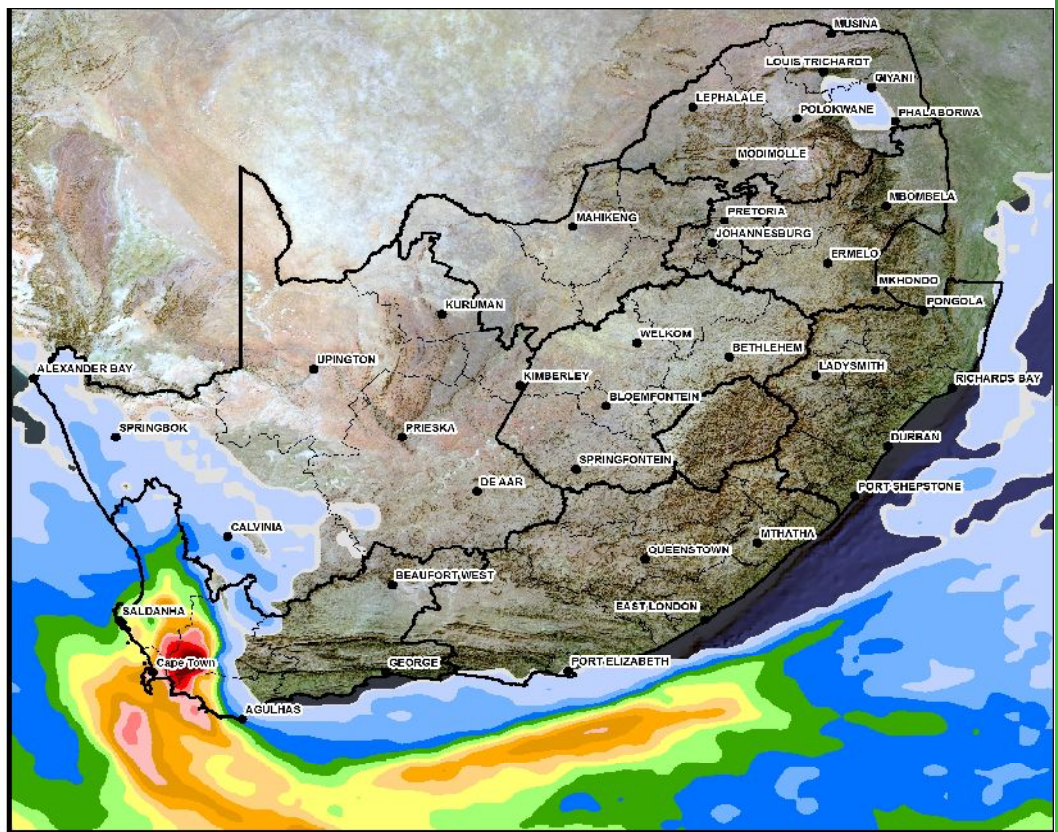
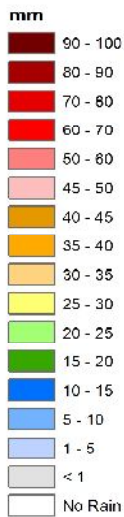


Figure 1: Expected precipitation 12 to 18 June 2018.

The summer rainfall region can expect a dry week while the Western Cape and western Northern Cape can look forward to some rainfall. The large cold front expected to make landfall on Thursday will bring heavy showers to especially the Western Cape (40 mm and more).





Average Minimum Temperatures: 12 to 18 June 2018

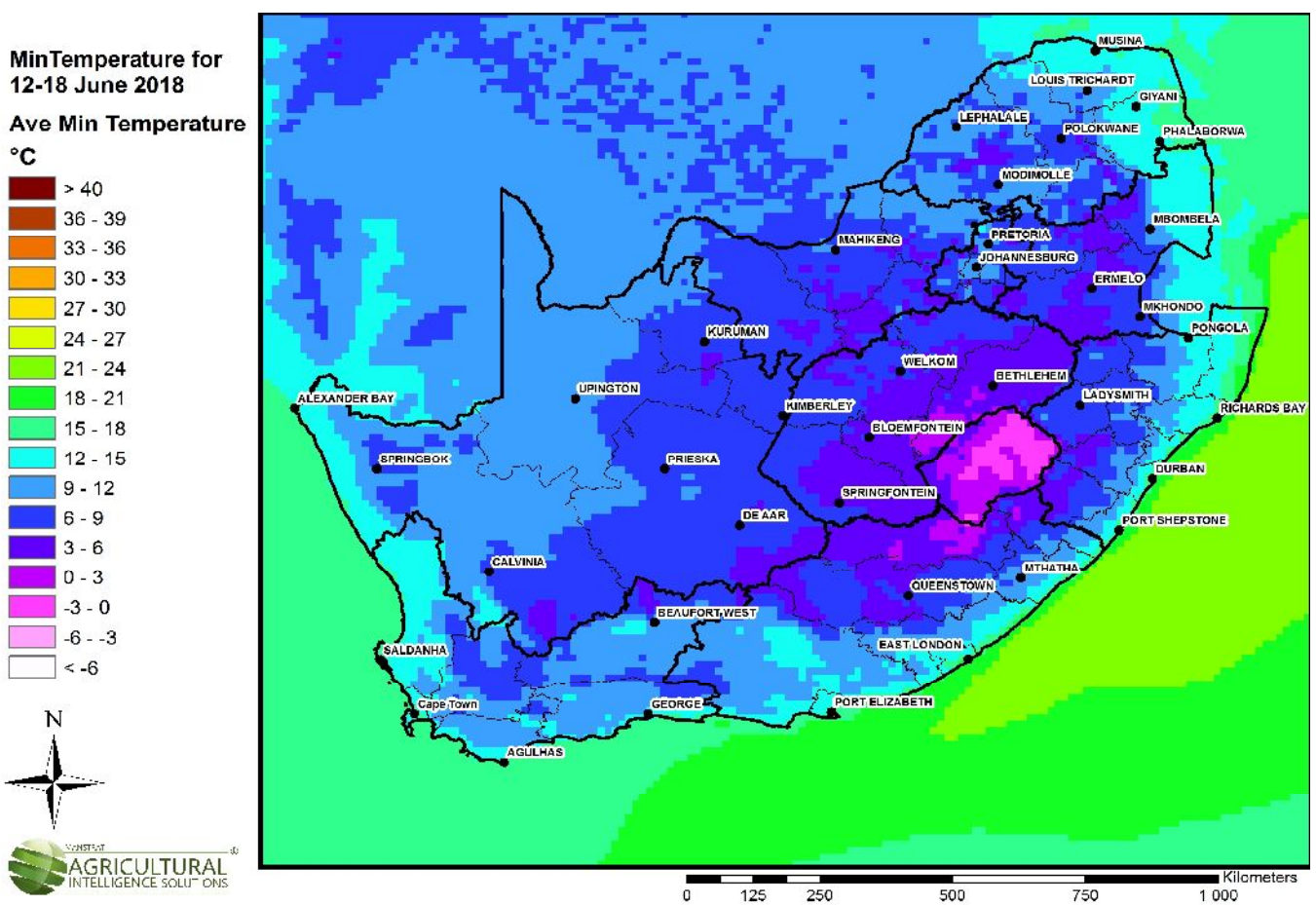


Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 12 to 18 June 2018.

Minimum temperatures between 6°C to 9°C are foreseen for the interior of the country, while mild minimum temperatures of between 12°C to 15°C are expected along the coastal regions.

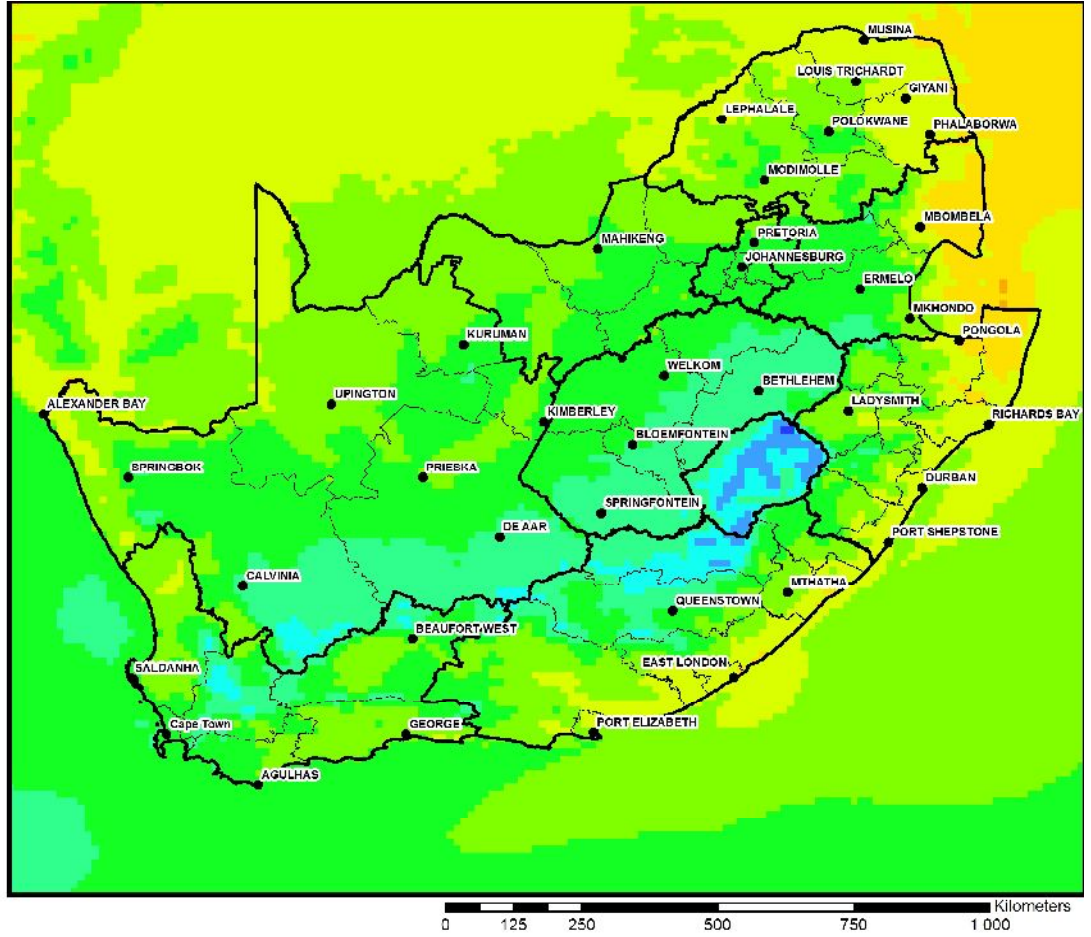


Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 12 to 18 June 2018.

Maximum temperatures of between 18°C to 21°C are expected across South Africa for the period. Warmer temperatures will prevail along the east coast, eastern Mpumalanga and Limpopo with temperatures between 24°C to 27°C.
