



Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 3 to 9 July 2018.

A strong cold front made landfall on the weekend of 29 June 2018 bringing heavy showers and snow to various parts of the Western Cape and will bring more showers to the region on Tuesday. There's a possibility of isolated showers over KwaZulu-Natal this week, with the likelihood of showers over parts of Limpopo and Mpumalanga over the weekend.





Average Minimum Temperatures: 3 to 9 July 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 3 to 9 July 2018.

Due to the heavy snowfalls over large parts of the Western and Eastern Cape between Saturday and Monday, the average minimum temperatures will be extremely low for this week, but should return to the winter norm for most parts of the country by the weekend.



Average Maximum Temperatures: 3 to 9 July 2018




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures: 3 to 9 July 2018.

Maximum temperatures will be affected this week due to snowfalls over the Western and Eastern Cape. Temperatures will be much lower at the start of the week but will gradually recover to normal temperatures for this period, around the weekend.
