

## Weekly Outlook: Rainfall: 17 to 23 July 2018




Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 17 to 23 July 2018.

## Average Minimum Temperatures: 17 to 23 July 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 17 to 23 July 2018.

While minimum temperatures are set to recover over the western half of South Africa, the eastern half of the country will experience its coldest minimum temperatures this winter as a result of the weekend's cold front.

## Average Maximum Temperatures: 17 to 23 July 2018




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures: 17 to 23 July 2018.

Mild maximum temperatures (24°C to 27°C) are expected along the coastal regions, while the rest of South Africa will experience much lower maximum temperatures during the coming week.
