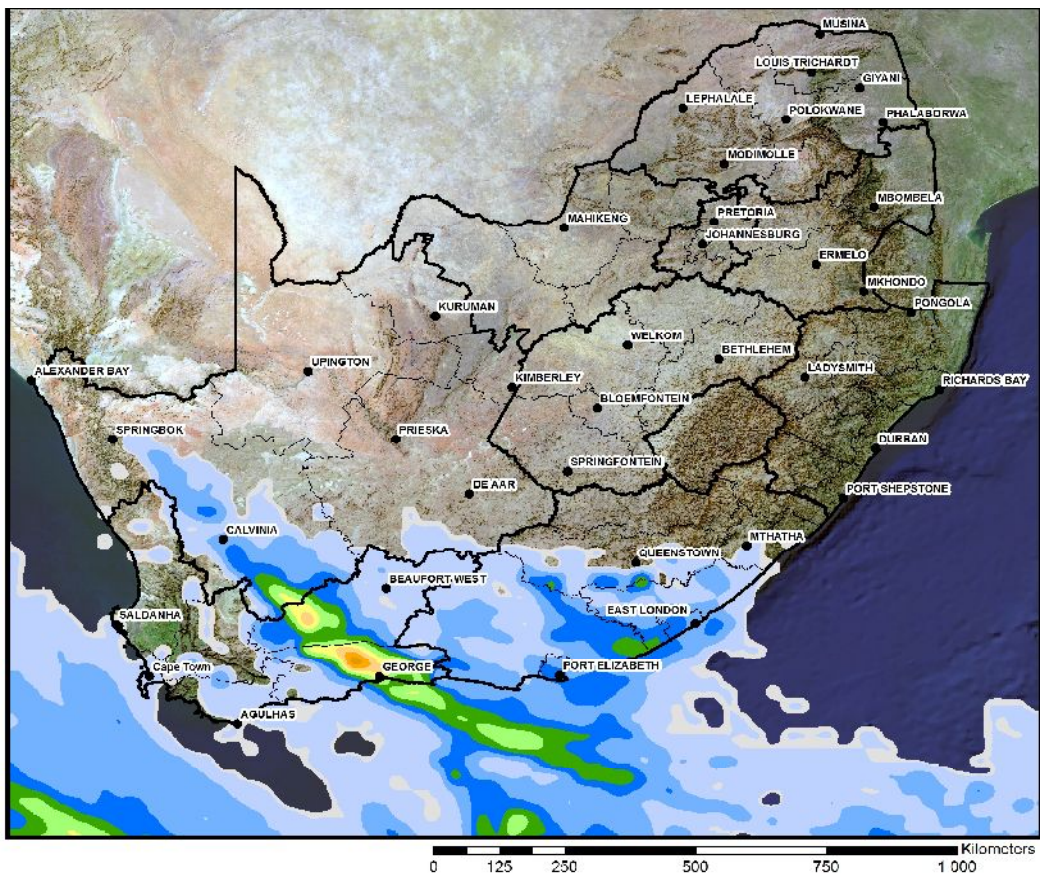
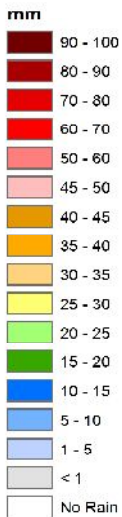

24-30 July 2018



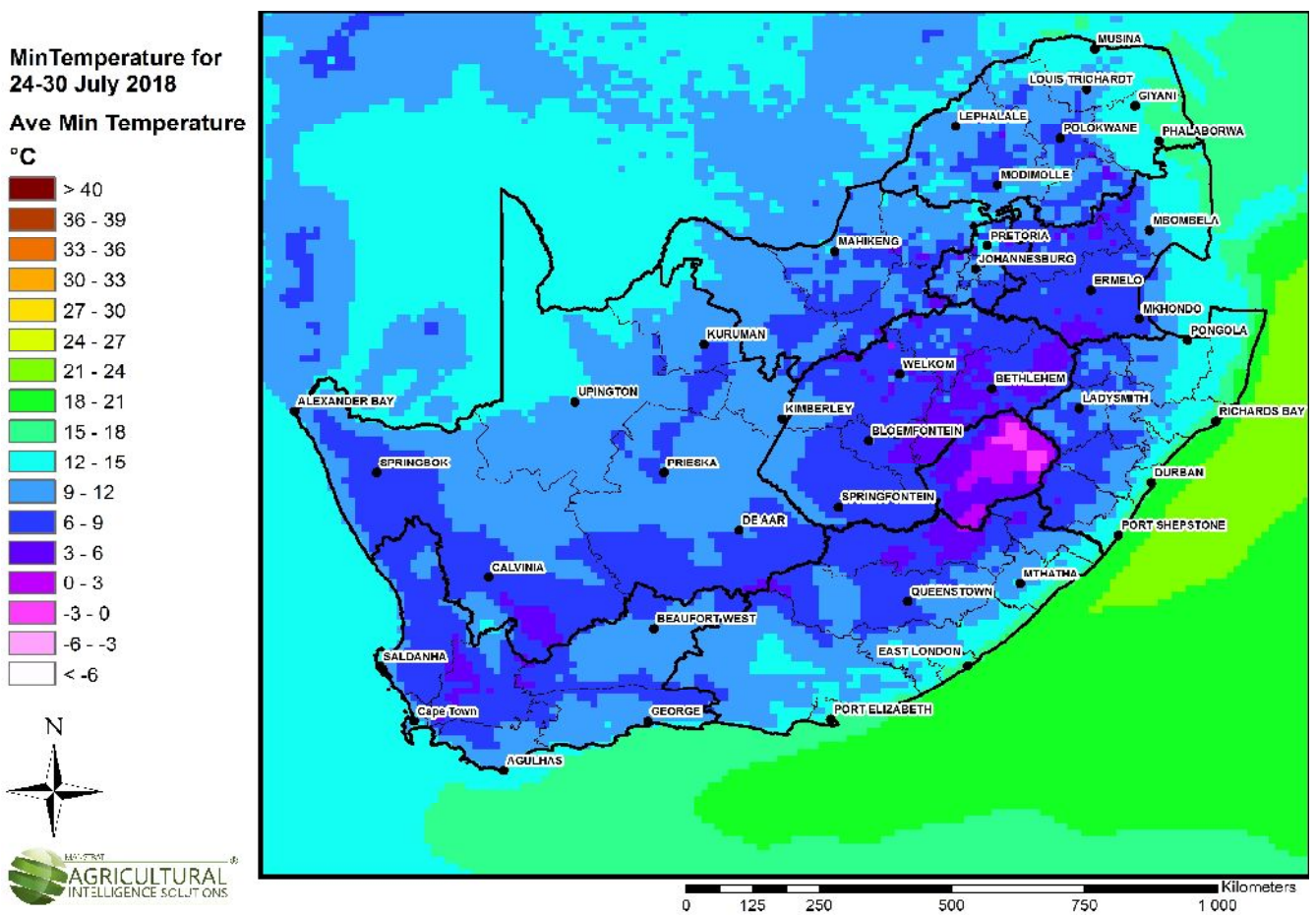
***Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 24 to 30 July 2018.***

## Average Minimum Temperatures: 24 to 30 July 2018

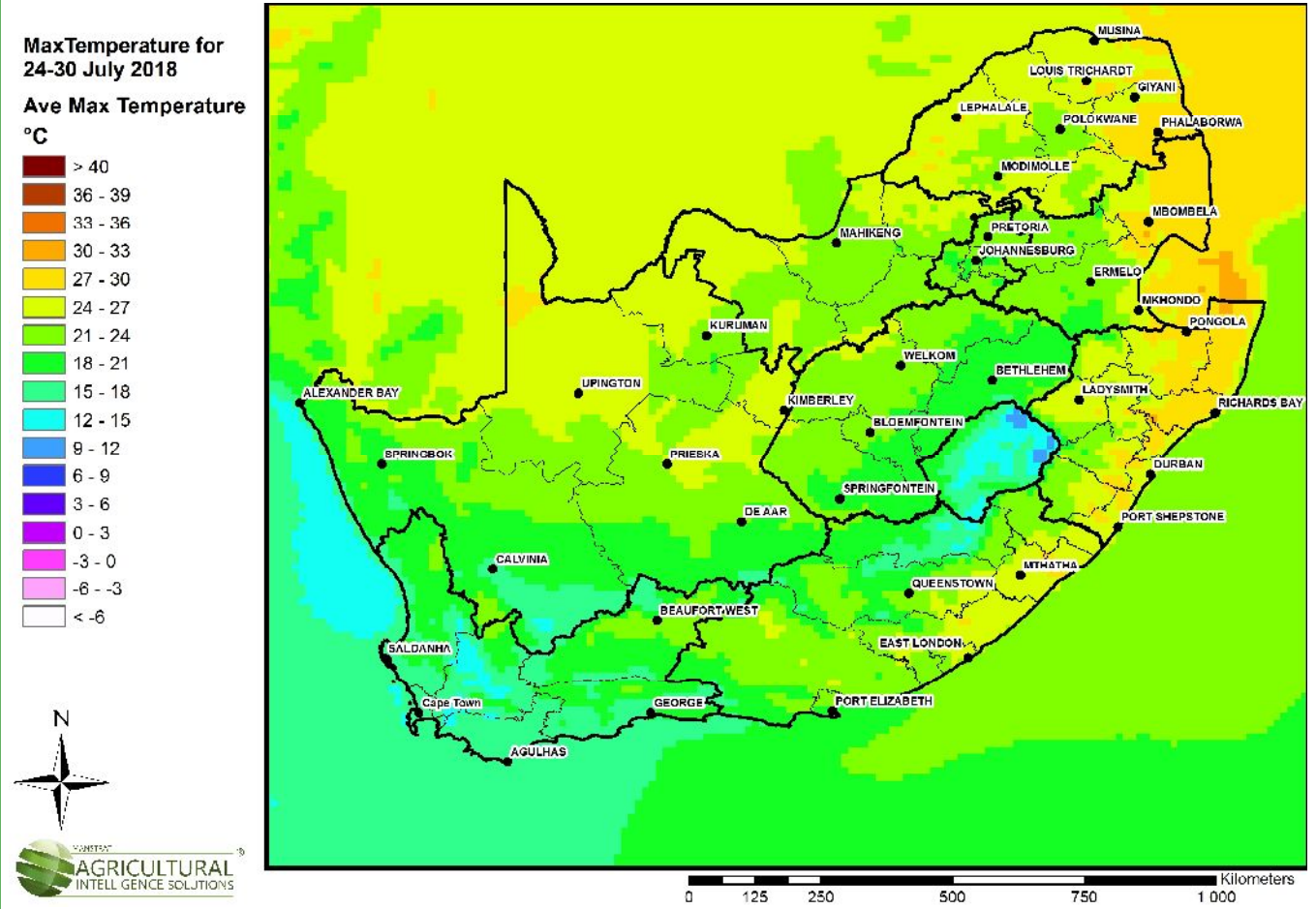


**Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 24 to 30 July 2018.**
