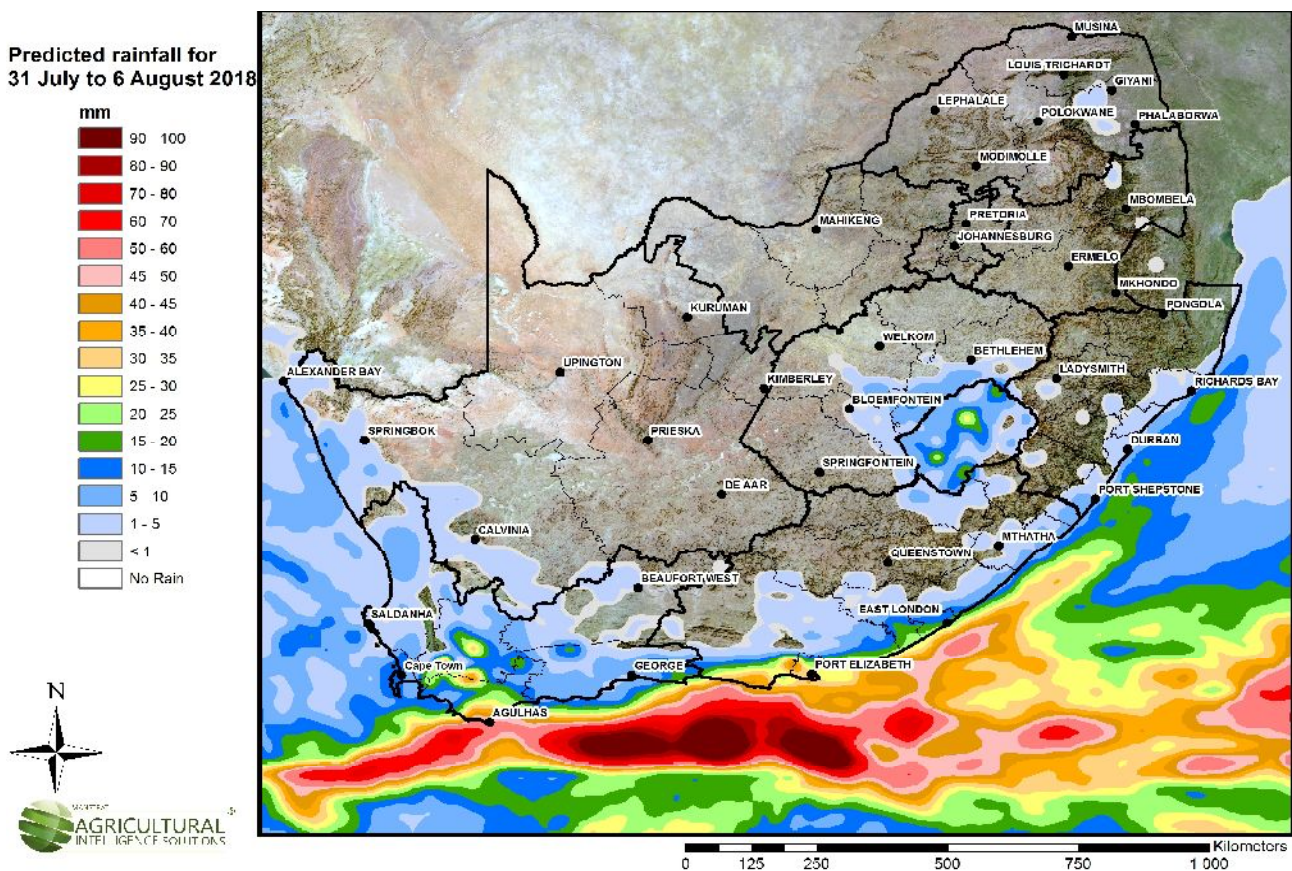

***Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 31 July to 6 August 2018.***

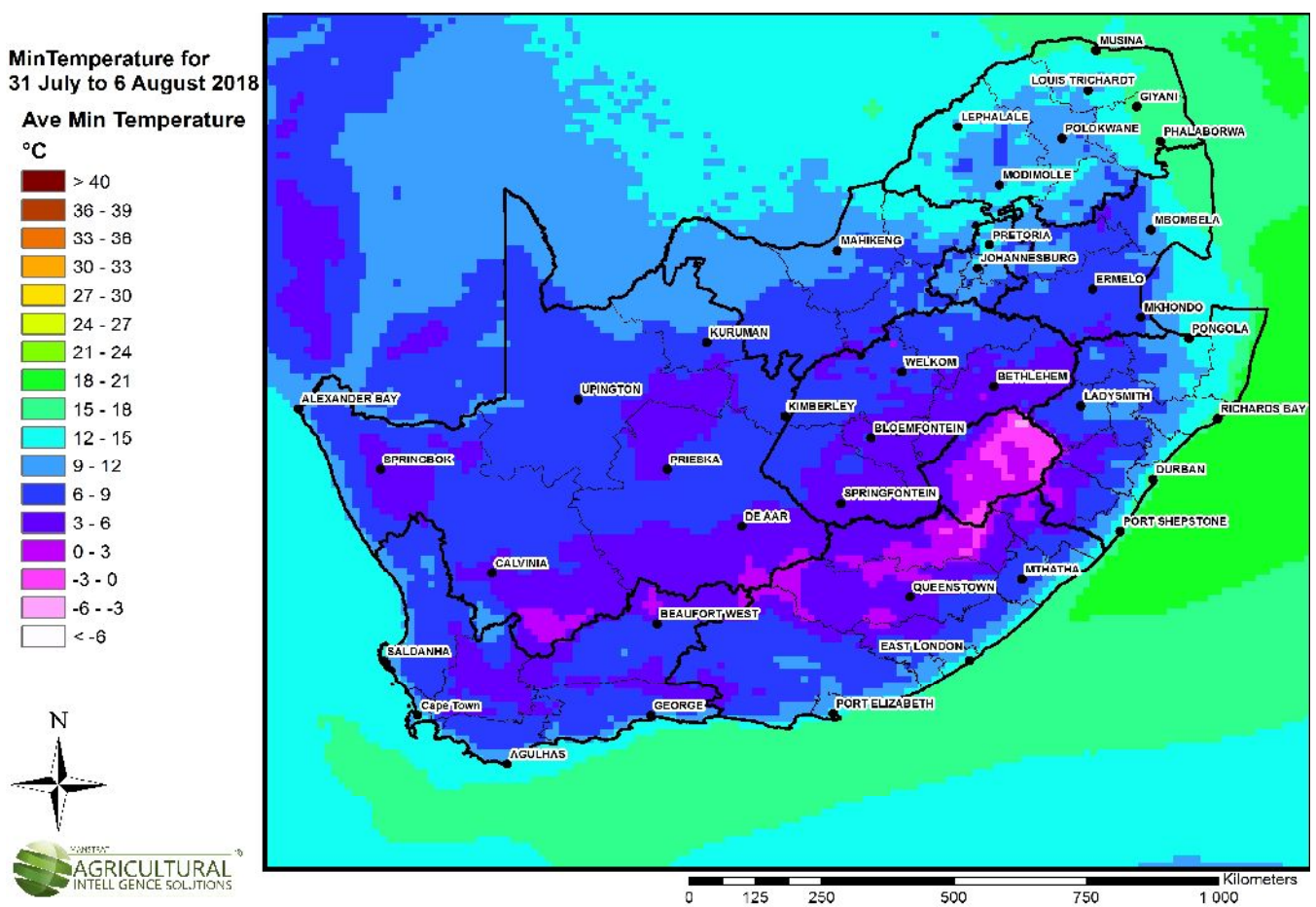
While another dry week is expected over South Africa, another major cold front is expected to make landfall in the Western Cape Province on Friday bringing rain to large parts of the province. It will then move northwards and bring rain along the eastern coastline areas over the weekend.

**Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 31 July to 6 August 2018.**

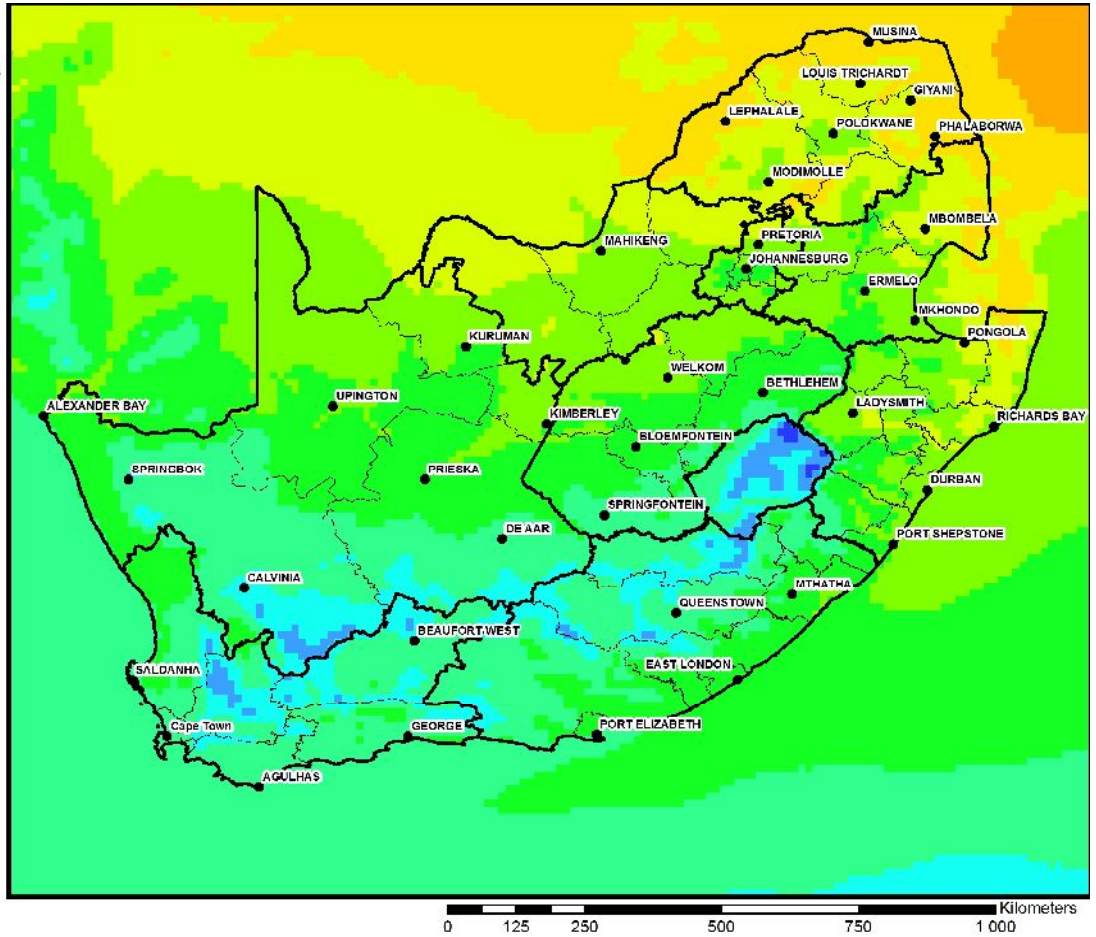
Although there has been further improvement in the minimum temperatures during the week, the cold front is expected to result in lower minimum temperatures at the weekend.

Maximum temperatures are expected to continue to increase during the week, but will drop to below 20°C during the weekend due to the old front over the eastern coastal areas.
