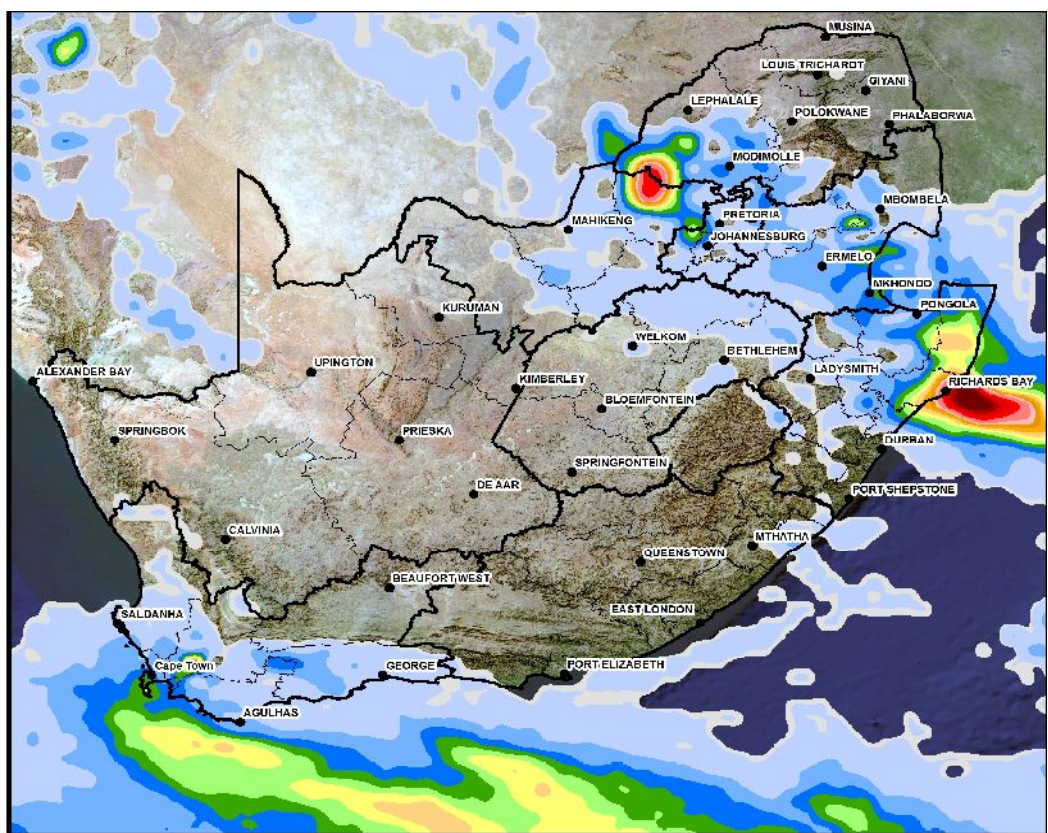
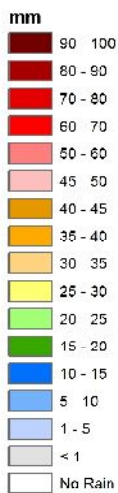

The Western Cape will receive rainfall throughout the coming week while the rest of South Africa remains dry. Large parts of the summer rainfall region will experience the first thunderstorms of the season from Friday, and throughout the weekend. The most significant rainfall for the week is expected over the northern regions of KwaZulu-Natal (20 mm and more is expected over most areas).



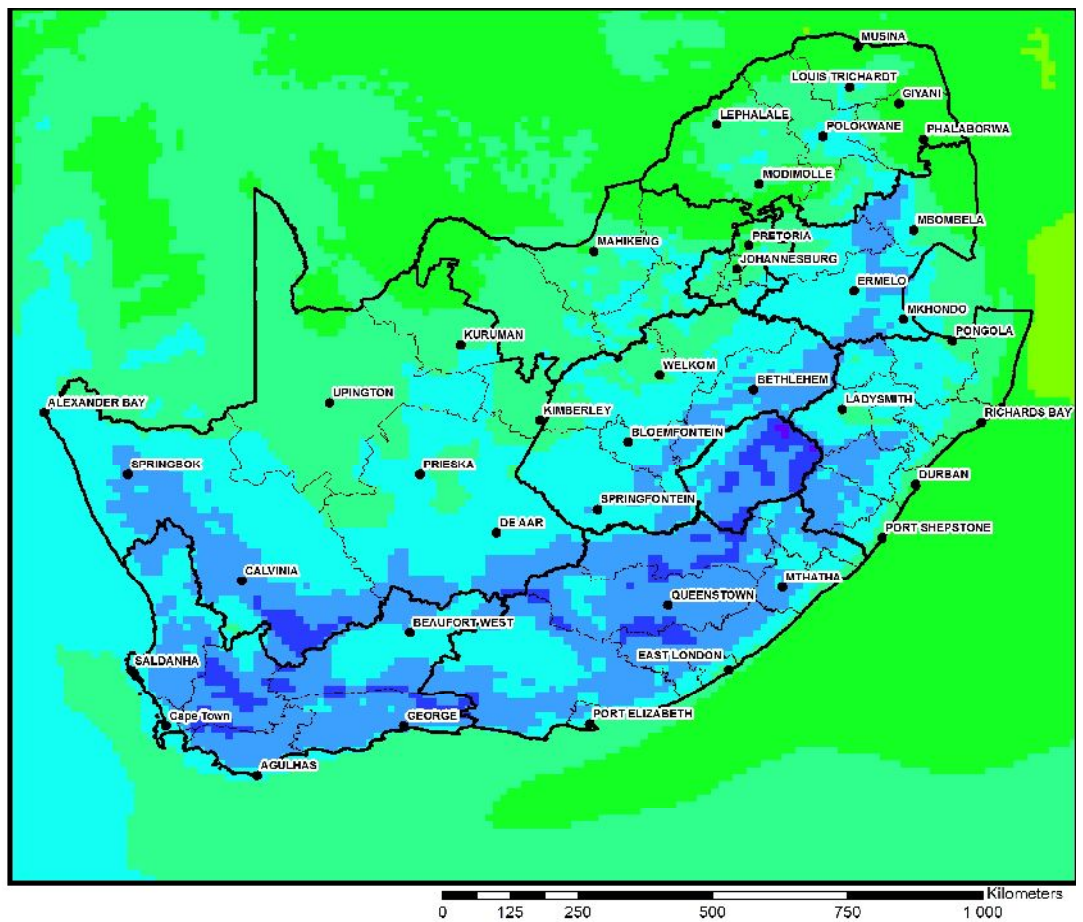
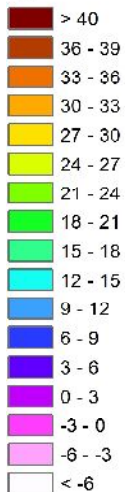




## Average Minimum Temperatures: 26 September to 2 October 2018

**Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 26 September to 2 October 2018.**

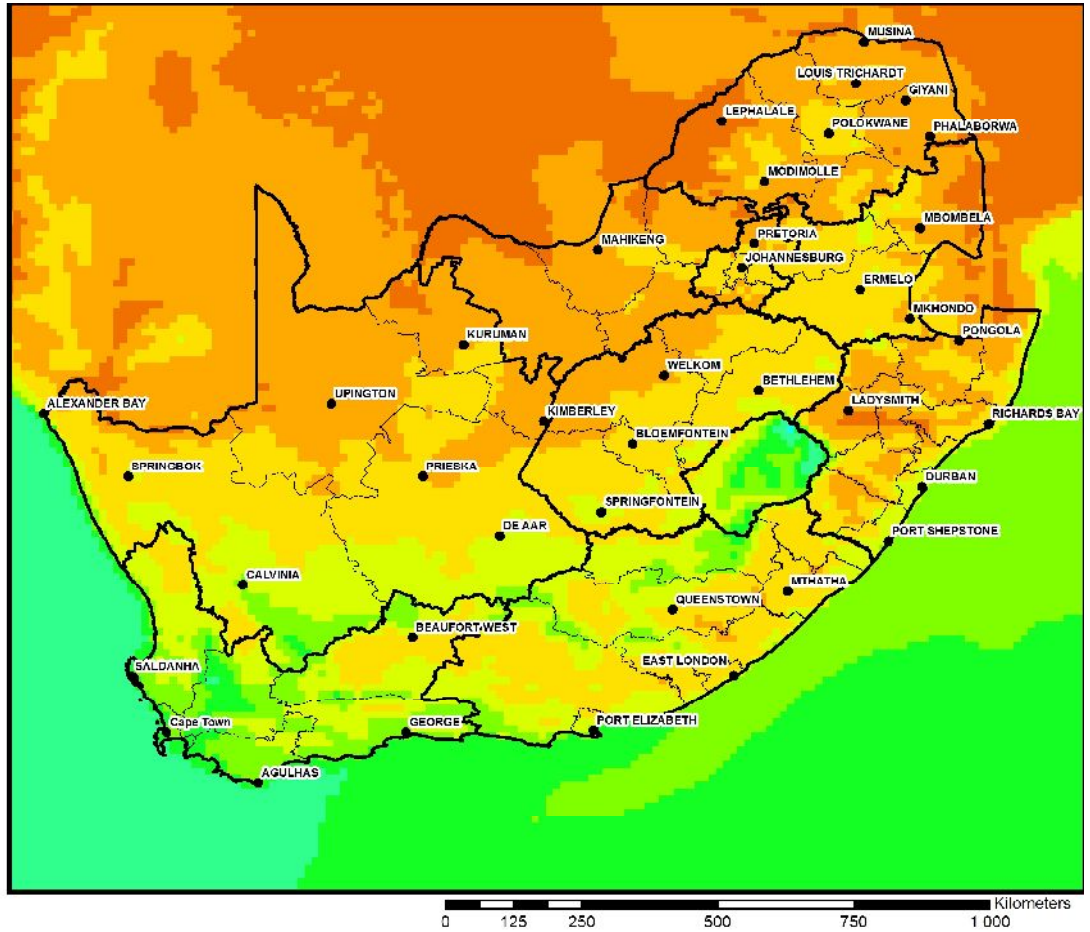
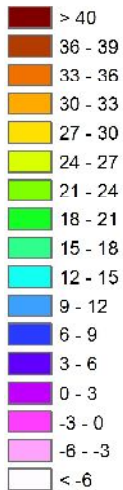
Minimum temperatures of not lower than 10°C are expected for most areas, while minimum temperatures above 15 C are expected for the northern regions of South Africa.
